Entry fee is \$20/person. Register with Wayne Friday Evening or before 6:45AM Saturday at the Kern River Archery Range. Final instructions will be given with official start of the shoot at 7AM. Check in by 7PM Saturday evening. Fail to check in by 7PM and you will be ineligible for awards. No Exceptions! Weigh-in begins at 7PM Saturday. Register your biggest fish in Small Game Club for \$3.00 and see your name and picture in the next publication of the CBH/SAA Big Game Club Record Book. Registration Forms provided. Dry Camping FREE courtesy of the K. R. Archers. Coffee and donuts Saturday morning at range. Boats OK but most shooting is in knee deep water at shore line.

Directions: Highway 99 to Bakersfield. Go east approximately 52 miles on **Hwy 178** to the town of **Lake Isabella**. Take **Exit #42**. Right on **Elizabeth Norris Rd.** Left on **Lake Isabella Blvd.** Right on **Erskine Creek Rd.**, cross the canal, pass church on left and turn left into **K. R. Archery Range**. **From Riverside take I-15** north to **Hwy 395** north to **Hwy 178** to the town of **Lake Isabella**. Take **Exit #43**. Left on **Hwy 155 / Kernville Rd.** Right on **Lake Isabella Blvd.** Left on **Erskine Creek Rd.**, then follow the above directions to the range.
